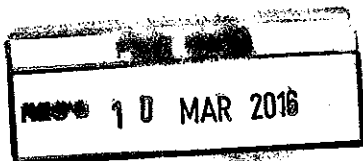

Notwithstanding the wildlife, Cheddle is choc-a-bloke with all manner of transport passing through and Ashbourne Road is quite often grid-locked at the top of Thorley Drive, as it only takes a minor incident at the small roundabout by the Lamplighter public house - or cars / vans parked opposite the entrance to Asda to grind traffic to a halt. Even the Saturday before Mothers Day saw a huge increase on this road with Motorists getting really cross at this roundabout and deciding not to give way whilst travelling from the Tenn end. This proposed development would simply put more vehicles on these already congested minor roads.
