

Shopfront Screen Construction

- Typical Mullion:
 44x169 with ovolo profiles to loose arrisses.
 Planted 19x60 lambs tongue mouldings to form door/ glazing rebates (fully glued, biscuits for cligament)
- for alignment).

 Ovolo glazing bead.

 Weather strip to door jambs (Sealmaster Deluge or equal to approval.

Doors:
- 44x144 stiles and top rail, ovolo moulding. - 44x244 bottom rail, ovolo moulding.- Sealmaster Cyclone TDS/WFH threshold &

weather mould.

- Weather strip as above.

- Ironmongery:
 Self closers Briton 1120b (adjustable 2-4 and backcheck).
 Pull handles Carlisle Brass SWP19/300, satin stainless steel finish.
 Finger plates Carlisle Brass sss finish.
 Letter plate (shop only) Carlisle Brass sleeved letter plate, sss finish.
 Locking key operated latch with internal release via video intercom. Key suited with flat entrance keys. entrance keys.

Glazing:
- 8.8mm laminated safety glass to door.
- double glazed unit 6mm laminated safety glass: 16mm: 4mm glass sealed units to fixed panels
- Numbering in plain glass to be vinyl applied to stehod glass.

to etched glass.

Timber:
- All joinery to be of a durable hardwood (manufacturer's selection).

- All plywood to be WBP birch (thin veneers).

Finish:
- All joinery to be painted colour TBC externally.


