The installation of a new 17.5m high CU Phosco phase 4.5 column/monopole in galvanised steel finish, on new concrete base with 3No antennas and 1No 0.6m dish, manufactured in grey colour. 3No cabinets painted green and 1No electrical meter cabinet painted green (the largest cabinet being 770 x 750 x 1925mm). All within a 7m x 7m compound enclosed by a 1.2m high stockproof timber post and rail fence.
