

Proposed Installation of an ATM

Heritage Statement

The site is a two storey building, shop front and white render. The ATM has been installed to the left of the glazed entrance door replacing glazing to the window frame with a white laminate security infill panel incorporating the ATM fascia and top sign only.

Alterations to the existing shop front elevation to accommodate the installation of the ATM are in materials which comply with existing materials and colours of the front elevation and are sympathetic in terms of Heritage. The original window frame has been retained with no design layout alterations to the aluminium glazed shop front.

The design of the ATM is moderate in scale and colouration and signage is a standard design installed by Cardtronics Cashzone throughout the UK.

Assessment of Heritage Significance

Historical, architectural and artistic interest in the site are not effected in terms of any design impact of the installed ATM materials, design and graphics are all consistent with the existing design, style and graphics of the shop front fascia signs in the retail high street.

Assessment of Impact

Impact of the installation have minimal impact in terms of design on the Heritage Assets of the site.

Mitigation

Mitigation strategy has been to minimise design impact by choice of location and materials used to make this installation totally integrated with the current design of the front elevation.

Design Principals

The ATM is of a standard design as located in many Convenience Stores throughout the UK and is accepted as a necessary facility. There are a number of mandatory standards which apply relating to the position of the ATM, it's visibility, ambient lighting, building structure, security features, ATM anchoring and ATM safe security and strength. Careful consideration has been given to this installation and the choice of installed materials in a site with heritage assets.
