Submission: Objection

Comments: The planning request will cause considerable disruption by moving a public area near to our residential property. There is already considerable disturbance caused by noise and behaviour of patrons of the pub until late and this will bring them even closer to our property. I do not think this is acceptable as the current arrangements provide suitable parking provisions for patrons and also there is only what can be described as suitable garden and recreational facilities already at the site.

There is also the fact that this movement will also disturb long standing rights of way and public walkways and impede access to them.

This is a long established situation that has satisfied the needs of the pub and the community for the past 20 years we have lived next door. I have grave concerns about the environmental impact of this on this semi rural area and also the noise pollution this will also impose on our 8 year old son who happens to have a bedroom that will be within earshot of what may well become a 'beer garden' which I do not think he should be subjected to.

I have serious concerns about how this seemingly unnecessary change will impact not only our home existence for myself and my young family but also the impact this may also have on the value of our house given this apparent unnecessary moving of parking from one side of the site to another.

We as a family fail to see any benefits to this change that cannot be met by the current situation as there is already a car park and already a beer garden.
