The photographs below provide an indication of the visual appearance, design and approximate scale of the buildings proposed as part of the outdoor recreational facility at Huntley Wood Quarry. Drawings within the planning supporting statement should be referred to for the dimensions of the proposed buildings.

Additional information regarding the building design and function is provided in Section 3 of the planning supporting statement.

Communal Building and Toilets

The photographs below show the style of the proposed communal buildings and toilet blocks. The applicant proposes that the buildings used at Huntley Wood would be a muted natural colour to blend in with the setting of the site. These buildings would be constructed from thick logs and would have double glazed doors and windows. The buildings at Huntley wood would have an overhanging roof as shown but not the small wall around the veranda.















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Club House

The photograph below provides an indication of the style of the proposed Club House provided by Border Oak. The Club House would be an oak framed building using green oak and traditional construction methods. The oak frame would be clad with weather boards and insulated. Drawing 1076.1B in the planning supporting statement provides elevations and dimensions of this proposed building.

Managers Temporary Dwelling

The photograph below shows the style of the proposed managers dwelling. The elevations and dimensions of the dwelling are shown on Drawing 005 of the planning supporting statement.





Huntley Wood – Outdoor Recreational Facility

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The Communal Building would be constructed using three cabins in this style and would be connected by an enclosed wooden walkway as shown on Drawing 001.







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
