Grass areas to be turfed.
All trees are to be planted as shown ensuring a minimum depth of 300mm, to have all rubbish and debris cleared away, and to be backfilled with min.300mm depth of good quality weed free topsoil to BS 3882 (1994).
On completion of planting all planted areas are to be lightly forked over and spread with a 50mm deep mulch of bark chippings.
All plants and planting to comply with the requirements of all current/relevant British Standard Specifications including BS 3936:Part I (1992), Part II (1990) and Part IV (1984) and BS 6326 (1975) where applicable. BS 4428 (1989) "Recommendation for Tree Work" shall comply with any existing TPO requirements and shall require the approval of the Landscape Architect.

Existing Trees and Hedges etc.
Where existing trees are shown to be retained they should be subject to a full arboricultural inspection for safety.
All existing trees and hedges shown to be retained are subject to BS 5837 (1991) "Code of Practice for Trees in Relation to Construction" and should be fully fenced with chestnut pale fencing at the extent of their canopy prior to the commencement of any works.
Any surgery required shall be in accordance with BS 3998 (1989) "Recommendation for Tree Work" shall comply with any existing TPO requirements and shall require the approval of the Landscape Architect.

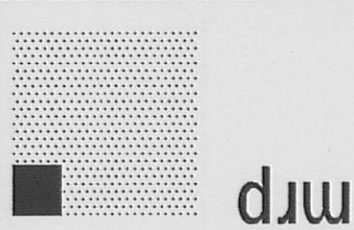
