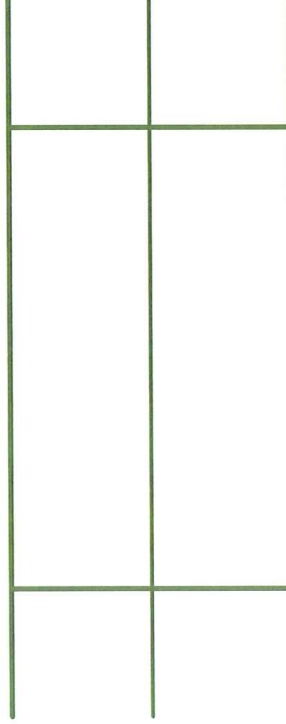
Type 1D with Diamond Trellis
